### ARTICLE I Purpose and Policy

The parties hereto declare it to be their purpose and policy to establish an organized, planned system of apprenticeship, conducted as an employer and employer association undertaking. These standards have, therefore, been adopted and agreed upon under the Shelley-Maloney Apprentice Labor Standards Act of 1939, as amended, to govern the employment and training of apprentices in the Craft defined herein, to become effective upon their approval.
